

Saint Report Confirmation

The beauty of the saints is beyond description. The Lord has given us the opportunity to strive for holiness and spend an eternity with him in glory. The saints sometimes seem to be magical or fairytale figures in our time, but through the Lord's helping hand we too can attain sainthood-- better yet, we are called to be saints. The saints pray for us during times of trial just as our friends or families do. During Confirmation you have had the opportunity to learn about multiple saints from the early church history to the newly canonized saints. This is your opportunity to prayerfully consider which saint is calling out to you and will direct you to a path of holiness. It is necessary that you research the particular saint that you wish to be your patron, learn about their history, their particular mode of prayer and reflect on why you are choosing this saint to help you on your journey to eternal salvation.

After you have chosen your patron saint, please write a report incorporating the information below:

1. Write a report that is at least 250 words in length, typed and double-spaced. Be sure your name, Confirmation Year, and date are in the upper right hand corner.
2. Describe how you came to find this saint and why you are choosing this saint to be your patron for Confirmation and beyond.
3. What do you hope to gain by choosing this saint as your particular patron and intercessor?
